What to do about waste?

Our district has a highly effective system for disposing of waste. However, it can only work properly if everyone participates and consistently separates their waste. In our system, we differentiate between waste that is collected and picked up at your home and other types of waste that can be brought to our disposal facilities and recycling centres.

Collection service



Many types of waste are collected from your doorstep.



General waste bin

Your general waste bin is black and is emptied every four weeks. It is available in 35, 60, 80, 120 and 240-litre sizes. Every household in Freudenstadt District is obliged to use a general waste bin with sufficient capacity (of at least 35 litres) for a charge or alternatively join a container community ("Behältergemeinschaft").



General waste bag

For short-term additional requirements. Available from all local authorities for a charge.



Biomass (organic) waste bin

Your biomass waste bin for organic waste is brown and is emptied every two weeks. It can be used at no additional charge. Please avoid leaving any plastic, glass or metal in it. Similarly, the biomass bin is not the right place for compostable plastic bags, films or packaging.



Paper bin

The paper bin for the disposal of waste paper has a blue lid and is emptied every four weeks. It is provided free of charge.



Yellow bag

The yellow bag is used for the collection of lightweight packaging. Glass or paper packaging or packaging components should not be placed in the yellow bag.

The yellow bags are collected every four weeks by Remondis Süd GmbH, Freudenstadt branch (telephone 0800 1223255).



Removal of bulky waste and wooden furniture

These types of waste are removed twice a year. No additional fees are payable. Bulky waste and wooden furniture must be separated (maximum 3 cubic metres per household).



Garden waste

Tree and shrub prunings are collected twice a year. The waste must be bundled up prior to collection.

Collections start as early as 6.30 am.

For collection dates, please refer to the waste calendar, the online waste calendar or the waste app.

Drop-off Service

You can also drop off your waste at the waste disposal facilities, recycling centres or recycling points.



Waste disposal facilities

Acceptance of all types of waste including construction waste, in some cases for a fee.



Recycling centres

Free-of-charge drop-off of recyclable materials, green and garden waste, and hazardous and problematic substances.



Recycling points

Large containers for waste paper and glass waste.



Collection of hazardous and problematic substances

Collection by the hazardous substance mobile facility twice a year at all locations across the district. Collection dates and locations can be found at www.awb-fds.de.



Drop-off of bulky waste and wooden furniture

With a bulky waste voucher, you can drop off up to 3 cubic metres of bulky waste and wooden furniture free of charge at the waste disposal facilities once a year. You can also do this without a voucher; however, a fee will then be payable.

This is how you should separate your waste...

During a period characterised by climate change and scarcity of resources, it is important to avoid creating waste wherever possible. Even so, waste cannot be completely avoided. The waste created, however, is certainly not worthless. Valuable materials suitable for recycling can be obtained from many types

of waste that are produced in the home. This represents a highly concrete way of reducing our consumption of resources. And it's why it is so important to separate waste to avoid everything ending up with the general waste.

Metal items or equipment.



Organic waste

Food and food waste from private households. No plastic, glass or metal.



Waste paper

Newspapers, magazines and paper of all kinds as well as cardboard and paperboard.



Glass waste

Packaging made of glass such as glass bottles not subject to a deposit, jam jars and perfume bottles. No drinking glasses or tableware.



Lightweight packaging

All types of packaging apart from paper and glass. Please separate packaging components from each other.

Wooden furniture

Scrap

Wood from residential and indoor areas but

not construction and renovation waste.

Electrical and electronic waste Anything with a cable, plug or battery.

Green waste / garden waste Anything that grows in the garden and needs



Waste wood A1-A3 grades

Types of wood that have been left untreated or that have been with treated with organic agents.





Hazardous and problematic substances

Environmentally hazardous waste such as paints, varnishes, solvents, used medicines, household and car batteries, alkalis, acids and spray cans.



Waste wood A4 grade

Wood that contains environmentally hazardous substances (such as wood preservatives) or to which these are attached.



Bulky waste

Bulky waste refers to any bulky items of general waste. Such waste is classed as bulky if, even when it is broken down to a reasonable degree, it will not fit in a (60-litre) general waste bin. Recyclable materials are not classed as bulky waste.



Household / general waste

Types of waste other than recyclable materials and hazardous waste.
